Q: Tell us about CAPITAL's relationship with High Point Networks.

Q: What challenge(s) did the solution that was implemented solve for CAPITAL Services?

A: CAPITAL is always looking to eliminate single points of failure, and by replacing the external firewalls with the HA pairs, we have

become more resilient. The solution provides us the hardware performance to turn on all features, such as SSL decryption, no matter where the traffic is in our network.

Q: How did having a project manager specifically assigned to your company help streamline your project?

A: High Point is always there to follow through from the beginning to end to make sure the project is successful.

Q: What is an example of how HPN has gone "the extra mile" to serve you during this project?

A: We had a unique timeline on the firewall project due to the expiring license of the existing hardware. Ryan Fonder was able to work out a deal with the vendor to ensure we were covered for our subscriptions and licensing to guarantee we were able to plan and implement correctly. Ryan also facilitated one day replacements after a mix up during the switch redundancy project, preventing a delay in the implementation.
